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EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

Nav Uday Kiran is a registered non-governmental organization (NGO) committed to bringing positive change in the lives of underprivileged, marginalized, and vulnerable communities. Founded on the principles of **equity, dignity, and empowerment**, the organization works extensively in the areas of **education, health, livelihood development, women empowerment, youth engagement, and community mobilization**.

Over the past year, Nav Uday Kiran has implemented several impactful programs in both rural and urban areas. These initiatives are designed to provide sustainable solutions to deep-rooted socio-economic problems. Our approach combines **grassroots-level intervention, capacity-building workshops, skill development, and public-private partnerships** to deliver measurable outcomes.

The organization has strengthened its collaboration with government bodies, CSR wings of private sector companies, and local self-help groups (SHGs) to maximize reach and effectiveness. With a focus on **transparency, accountability, and community ownership**, we ensure that every intervention is need-based, inclusive, and sustainable.

Key achievements in the reporting year include:

- Enrollment of over **800 children** in remedial education programs.

- Launch of **skill training programs** in tailoring, computer literacy, and beautician courses for **rural youth and women**.
- Active disaster relief and COVID-19 awareness campaigns in vulnerable areas.

With a team of dedicated staff, volunteers, and well-wishers, Nav Uday Kiran aims to expand its footprint and continue serving with passion and integrity.

The journey of Nav Uday Kiran began modestly, operating from a single-room setup where it initially provided non-formal education to 25 children. The organization firmly upholds the belief that every child's fundamental needs are inseparable from their basic rights.

Founded in 2019, Nav Uday Kiran NGO was established with the vision of empowering marginalized communities and helping individuals realize their potential with dignity. It operates on the principle that real change begins at the grassroots level and that empowered individuals have the power to uplift entire communities.

The name **Nav Uday Kiran**, meaning “**Ray of New Dawn**,” reflects the organization's spirit of hope, renewal, and positive transformation. This vision is evident in all its initiatives—ranging from educating children in urban slums to empowering women in rural areas, raising healthcare awareness, and supporting sustainable livelihood opportunities.

- To work towards improving public health and hygiene, especially in low-income and rural communities, through awareness programs, health camps, and sanitation drives.

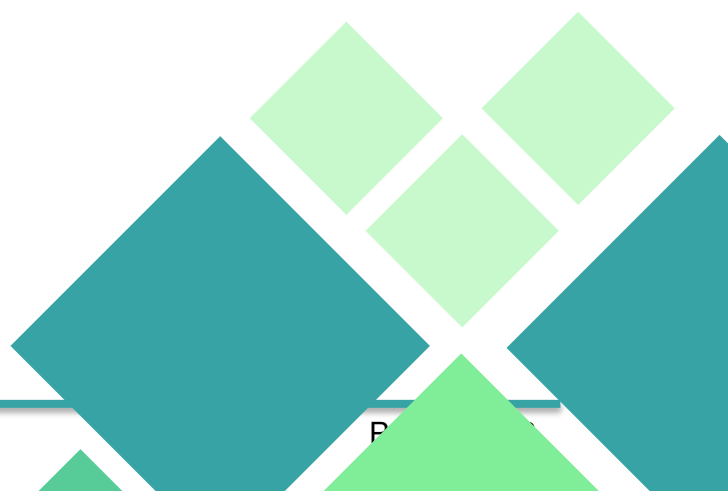

STORIES THAT TOUCHED US

One woman, *Savitri*, a 48-year-old domestic worker, had never had her blood pressure checked before attending our camp. She was diagnosed with severe hypertension. Thanks to early detection, she is now receiving regular treatment through a local clinic we partnered with.

Another case was *Ravi*, a 10-year-old boy found to be malnourished and anaemic. His mother received nutritional counselling and support packages through our network. Ravi is now on the path to recovery and a healthier childhood.

THE HEART OF IT ALL: COMMUNITY

None of this would have been possible without the heartfelt support of our volunteers, doctors, local partners, and donors. What truly drives us is the connection with the people we serve—listening to them, understanding their needs, and showing up consistently.

We are not just giving free check-ups—we are building **trust, awareness, and resilience** in communities that are often overlooked.

WHAT'S NEXT?

We are committed to scaling our efforts by:

- Organizing monthly health camps in new areas
- Collaborating with local schools for child health initiatives
- Introducing follow-up services for chronic patients
- Promoting menstrual health and hygiene education for adolescent girls

EDUCATION FOR ALL: OUR LEARNING CENTER

We run a **regular education center** for **elementary-level underprivileged children**, many of whom are first-generation learners.

Our Center Provides:

- Daily classes in reading, writing, math, and creative learning
- Free stationery, books, and learning materials
- A safe, nurturing environment with volunteer educators
- Confidence-building through activities and mentoring

ENVIRONMENT AWARENESS DRIVES

We believe education includes responsibility toward the Earth. Our **environmental programs** focused on:

- Tree plantation drives
- Clean-up campaigns in local slums and neighbourhoods
- Awareness workshops on waste segregation, plastic use, and water conservation
- Involvement of school children in eco-friendly projects



CULTURAL PROGRAMS: CELEBRATING IDENTITY & UNITY

We conducted **cultural events** that allowed children and youth from our community to express themselves through:

- Dance, music, poetry, and street plays
- National festival celebrations to foster unity
- Encouragement of local talent and traditions

These programs helped build **confidence, identity, and joy**—something often missing in struggling communities.



CAREER COUNSELING & YOUTH GUIDANCE

Recognizing the confusion many youth face after schooling, we initiated **career counselling sessions** to:

- Guide students on future education paths
- Inform them about vocational training options
- Provide motivational talks by professionals from various fields

WOMEN'S HYGIENE & AWARENESS

We held **women-centric workshops** focusing on:

- Menstrual hygiene and use of sanitary products
- Reproductive health and nutrition
- Distributing hygiene kits to adolescent girls and women
- Creating safe spaces for open discussion and support

FLOOD RELIEF & EMERGENCY RESPONSE

During the recent floods in nearby areas, our team quickly mobilized to provide:

- **Food packets, clean water, and blankets** to affected families
- Basic medical care and hygiene kits
- Emotional support and coordination with local authorities
- Helped rebuild temporary shelters and distributed clothes

Free Stationery & Resource Distribution

To support education and learning, we distributed:

- **Free notebooks, pens, pencils, school bags, and more**
- Special drives during the school admission season
- Learning kits for children who couldn't afford school supplies

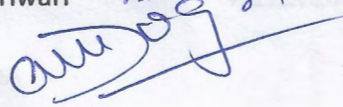
